

Joe Achenbach graduated as a Supply Corps Officer from the United States Naval Academy in 2002 with a B.S. in Economics and placement in the National Economics Honor Society. Prior to earning an appointment at the U.S. Naval Academy, he spent three years as an enlisted navy medic.
